Humane Society Takes First Step for Expansion

The Humane Society New Braunfels Area, Inc. (HSNBA) is taking the first step to build a new facility to expand its services. The Board of Directors has entered into an agreement to purchase 12 acres on Morningside Drive, with an additional 4.48 acres to be donated by the current owners to the Society. The 16+ acre tract will be the home of a new facility.

With the significant population increase in New Braunfels and Comal County, the Humane Society has seen a steady increase in the number of animals through its doors over the past 10 years. The new facility, will more than double the capacity of the current facility. When completed, it will accommodate the current and future needs of the animals and community. The building will feature more dog runs, a larger cat room, an adoption counseling room, a treatment room, animal play areas, adoption rooms, separate entrances for adoption and animal rescue/drop off, a classroom and conference area, and storage areas.

As a non-profit organization, through the generous donations from the public, the Humane Society is a major source of advocacy and protection for all animals. We abide by proactive spay/neuter initiatives, and work to educate the community on the importance of spaying and neutering. The Humane Society provides temporary loving care for impounded animals, adoptable animals, and animals displaced by or evacuated from natural disasters. Our primary goal is to find loving and safe homes for animals. The Humane Society provides animal housing and care for the City of New Braunfels, Comal County, and the City of Marion.
